First Conditional	If + present,	Will + infinitive
Used for real situations in the future	If I drink coffee at night,	I will not sleep tonight.
Second Conditional	If + past,	Would + infinitive
Used for imaginary situations (unreal future)	If I had more money,	I would go to the Caribbean.
Third Conditional	If + past perfect	Would + have + participle
Used for imaginary situations (unreal past)	If I had bought a better car,	I would have arrived in Germany on time.
